

TEAM RESPONSIBILITIES FOR THE TOURNAMENT

1. Players names and cap numbers shall be confirmed with the tournament controller at least 10 minutes prior to the first game of the tournament and should remain as little changed as possible throughout the tournament. The names from the first game are copied to the game sheets for the rest of the tournament, so teams must alter names on each subsequent game sheet if changes occur. Only those named registered with the Tournament Controller are permitted on the team bench during a match.
2. White caps start to the left hand side of the Secretary/Timekeepers table.
3. Caps: All teams shall supply their own caps, the colour of which shall be according to the programme. The team on the left hand side of the draw shall wear white caps. If bathing caps are worn under the water polo caps they should be the same colour as the designated water polo cap for each game. Teams must warm up with their caps on.
4. Players are not to change or leave personal belongings poolside adjacent to the match officials table.
5. Teams are asked not to move seating to the poolside to watch games. Viewing of games must be done from the grandstands.
6. Poolside changing is also banned by the pool. Offenders could be banned from the complex. Please use the changing rooms provided just outside the entrance to the pool.
7. Each game shall commence on time except when the referee with the agreement of both teams, may start a game earlier than set down in the programme.
8. Please ensure that the facilities at the pool are treated with respect. No other part of the pool is available for use unless booked through the pool management and paid for by the users. IE Finish Line Bar, Board room etc.
9. There are no pay phones available at MISH.
There will be food available from the Subway Restaurant and The Finish Line Restaurant will also be available at times during the tournament sometimes for refreshments and food.
10. We ask that spectators watch the games from the grandstands provided. If you wish to sit upstairs we do ask that you come through the main pool entrance and pay first please.

11. Health and Safety Regulations prohibit the consumption of food and drinks directly poolside. You are able to have food and drinks on the grandstand areas only. There are to be no glass bottles or glasses of any sort within the pool area. Please remove your rubbish or place in the bins provided. Players may have plastic drink bottles poolside.
12. The only people allowed on the team bench are the players the coach and the manager please. We do not tolerate bad or abusive language from any player, coach, manager or spectator.
13. U12 in 2006 means the player was born on or after 1st January 199. He/she is Under 12 years of age on 31st December 2006.
14. The U12 teams must be mixed and made up with at least three girls playing at the same time. In other words while your team is playing there must always be at least three girls in the pool at all times.
15. An official march past and opening ceremony will commence at 10am on Saturday 27th September.
16. Each team should be in their Club uniform and ready at the entrance to the pool for the beginning of the ceremony. There is an award for the best banner.
17. Please ensure you do not use the upstairs facilities for team talks. You must be outside of the Millennium or poolside for any talks.
